Audition Recital at Calder Academy:

Saturday, October 17<sup>th</sup> @ 6:30pm*(Additional auditions may be required in some cases)*

- All Students wishing to perform at Santa Clara University must AUDITION at the above-listed audition recital. The school will then select students representing various levels (beginning to advanced) from various teachers who will actually perform based upon a number of criteria: Quality of performance and presentation, accuracy of interpretation and execution, appropriateness of piece for each particular student, past performance experience of each student, etc.
- **No student will be allowed to perform who is deemed unprepared**
- Teacher Proposed Repertoire must be submitted to administration for director's review before the Evaluation Recital.
- Repertoire must be approved by director at the evaluation recital. If the student does not have much prior performance experience, it is recommended to choose shorter pieces and/or pieces which are well within the student's ability to improve their chances of playing well.
- Student / Teacher may select multiple pieces, however the director will have final say as to which pieces may be performed
- Total Concert Length will be limited to 2 hour 15 minutes, and will be aggressively enforced, therefore the following guidelines must be met by each student:
  - Student / Teacher must turn in the RECITAL FORM and specify the length of each piece, rounded UP to the nearest half-minute (i.e. 1min5sec would be 1:30min, 4min38sec would be 5min, etc)
  - Pieces will be timed for accuracy at the final evaluation. If length of your piece is inaccurate, your piece may be disqualified.
- Audition recital fee is \$5 per student.
- SCU performance fee is \$35 per student, plus \$30 for 6 tickets [**required**] (\$65 total).
- *Participation in school recitals is voluntary. If you feel you would not like to participate, please feel free to let your teacher know.*
